Dear Judge Wogan:

In Case Management Order #7, the Court established procedures for submittal of recommendations on the structure and process of future proceedings, and for submittal of responses to such recommendations. The Court has received recommendations from the Case Management Committee (Committee). Letter to Honorable Cameron F. Wogan from Sarah Weston and Darsee Staley Re: Attorney Committee Recommendations for Structure and Processing of Future Proceedings (Feb. 11, 2015) (Committee Letter). The Court has also received recommendations from a group of claimants. Recommendations for the Structure and Processing of Future Proceedings of Agency Seven, LLC; . . . [et al.] (Feb. 13, 2015) (Agency Seven Recommendations).<sup>1</sup> Below, the parties collectively referred to as Klamath Project Water Users<sup>2</sup> (KPWU) respond to and supplement the recommendations that have been submitted to date.

KPWU participated in the development of the Committee recommendations, and support them. Here, KPWU seek to build upon the Committee recommendations in anticipation of the Case Management Conference on March 18/19, 2015, and also respond to the Agency Seven Recommendations. KPWU expect to refer to all of the issues discussed below at the Case Management Conference, and hope that advance identification of these matters will help make the conference more efficient and productive.

KPWU are separately joining with the Klamath Tribes and United States in a letter of even date that concerns issues specific to that group of parties.

**A. Committee Letter “Phase 1” Issues**

The Committee recommendations contemplate a phased process, under which a significant goal is that a given issue raised or implicated in exceptions only be litigated once, and among the parties to whom it is or may be relevant. For “Phase 1,” the Committee has recommended a potential further division of issues into “threshold issues,” “procedural issues,” and “cross-cutting substantive issues[.]” Committee Letter at 2-4. While lines may blur between some of these classifications, we believe this overall general logic should assist the Court and parties and conserve resources. The Committee Letter also anticipates that the Court may wish to establish a process to identify Phase 1 issues. *Id.* at 4. KPWU will participate in that process, but in the meantime we identify the following at this time:

1. The Committee Letter identifies a non-exhaustive list of potential issues or classes of issues for resolution in Phase 1. Committee Letter at 3. It is possible the Court would direct parties to brief a specific Phase 1 issue on a schedule, or the Court could provide a schedule for filing and processing of motions by parties that relate to an issue, or some combination of these approaches may be appropriate. KPWU believe that, in most instances, it may be impractical to prescribe in advance the exact question upon which the Court will rule. However, we believe that it merits discussion, at the Case Management Conference, how a scheduling or case management order would be framed in order to both promote efficiency and allow parties the opportunity to seek the specific rulings that they support.
2. We believe that one “threshold issue” merits particular focus. Specifically, the Committee Letter identifies as a potential threshold issue: “Exceptions challenging OWRD’s authority to issue the [Amended and Corrected Findings of Fact and Order of Determination, or] ACFFOD, including, e.g., questions of notice of other issues of compliance with applicable law.” Committee Letter at 3. KPWU understand that there may be exceptions or other asserted positions of parties to the effect that the ACFFOD was not lawfully adopted. KPWU believe it important and appropriate that the Court establish a deadline for any party who wishes to contend, by exception or otherwise, that the ACFFOD or any of its components is not valid or was not lawfully adopted (for reasons suggested in the Committee Letter or otherwise), to file a motion seeking whatever relief the party requests. KPWU also recommend that the Court establish that no such motions will be entertained unless filed by the applicable deadline. The existence or potential existence of these issues also relates to the Agency Seven Recommendations, as discussed in section D of this letter.

3. The Committee Letter identifies, among the Phase 1 threshold issues, “Jurisdiction, *e.g.*, questions of standing, ripeness, or mootness.” Committee Letter at 3. KPWU believe that it is desirable that these sorts of issues be raised early. Assuming, however, that they can be raised at any time, KPWU believe it would be appropriate to so state, in any case management or scheduling order. KPWU also note the relationship of this “Jurisdiction” topic with another “threshold” topic that is characterized as “Exceptions concerning the rights of parties to pursue exceptions or requests to be heard.”<sup>3</sup> *Id.* at 3. A party may wish to seek rulings concerning the *principles that apply* to whether a given party may pursue an exception or exceptions, or participate by way of a request to be heard. KPWU thus recommend and request that the ultimate case management or scheduling order not preclude motions for this type of ruling.
4. The Committee Letter identifies, for Phase 1, a potential class of “cross-cutting substantive issues” that may apply to subsequent proceedings and be appropriate for adjudication “up front.” Committee Letter at 3-4. The Committee Letter does not describe any specific issues in this group, but anticipates that parties may do so. *Id.* at 3. KPWU believe there are issues appropriate for resolution under this category in Phase 1, and support the inclusion of at least the following issues in the scheduling order:
  - a. Issues regarding late-filed claims and amendments of claims, including consideration of all exceptions that relate to the ACFFOD’s general Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law at KBA\_ACFFOD\_0007-8 and KBA\_ACFFOD\_0041-47. This issue or group of related issues would also embrace the motions by Claimant Cameron Curtiss to Amend Claim No. 133 and by Claimants Steve and James Lawrence for an Order Amending Claim No. 13. (Those motions ask the Court for an order allowing the claimants to make amendments to their claims that OWRD disallowed as untimely.)
  - b. Issues related to the right or ability of parties to file claims in previously adjudicated sub-basins of the Klamath Basin, including issues referenced in the ACFFOD’s general findings and generally applicable conclusions on this subject. KBA\_ACFFOD\_0003-4; *see, e.g.*, Order Amending Rulings on Motions for Ruling on Legal Issues, KBA\_ACFFOD\_06241-6265.

- c. Any exceptions that concern the general “Introduction and Findings of Fact,” KBA\_ACFOD\_00001-14, and any exceptions that relate to any findings or elements of the ACFOD that are not within, or specifically incorporated into, a Partial Order of Determination.
- d. The availability of recovery of costs or attorneys’ fees in this proceeding. The Committee Letter notes that parties may have differing views on whether this issue should be decided up front in Phase 1 or only as a post-judgment matter. Committee Letter at 3, 8. KPWU believe it is appropriate to resolve the question early, at least to any recovery from a claimant or exceptor, because any possibility of such a recovery could factor importantly in the parties’ planning and prosecution of litigation to follow.

**B. Committee Letter “Phase 2”**

The Committee’s recommended Phase 2 would provide a simplified process for resolving exceptions that relate to purely typographical or other undisputed errors. Committee Letter at 4-5. The Committee Letter notes that it may be possible to proceed with this process without awaiting conclusion of the proposed Phase 1. *Id.* at 4. It also states that no exceptor would be required to participate in the Phase 2 process. *Id.*

KPWU recommend further that it be made clear that, although the Phase 2 process could proceed in parallel with Phase 1, parties would not be precluded from pursuing resolution of typographical or other undisputed errors later in the proceedings by efficient means, including using the same processes characterized as “Phase 2.” More generally, to the extent parties can reach stipulations that will dispose of exceptions or otherwise increase efficiency, the procedures should accommodate those actions.

**C. Committee Letter “Phase 3”**

KPWU have no supplemental or responsive comments regarding the Committee’s proposed Phase 3 at this time.

**D. Agency Seven Recommendations**

In the Agency Seven Recommendations, certain parties advocate that the structure and process for future proceedings “expedite the issuance of a partial decree applicable to certain, similarly situated claimants.” Agency Seven Recommendations at 1. The Agency Seven Recommendations also state that these parties recommend the issuance of partial decrees for certain water rights before resolving exceptions. *Id.* at 7. These parties also state that these partial decrees would allow the holders of the water rights identified in such claims to engage in water right transfers. *Id.* at 5. In the alternative, Agency Seven, et al., request that the

Court confirm “that those Partial Orders of Determination that were not specifically identified in exceptions will not be altered through the Court’s resolution of exceptions.” *Id.* at 2, 7.

KPWU understand the practical and policy purposes for the Agency Seven Recommendations. However, we believe that the Agency Seven Recommendations are premature, for a few reasons. First, as noted above, it appears that there are, or at least may be, exceptions that challenge the ACFFOD in total. If so, and putting aside whether any such exceptions would be likely to succeed, those issues must be resolved before the Court can issue a decree of any kind.

Second, the Agency Seven Recommendations present legal issues that require resolution, and thus go beyond recommendations for the structure of proceedings. Those legal issues include: (i) whether there is authority for adoption of a “partial” decree (and what the proper form of such a partial decree would be); (ii) whether water rights recognized in a partial decree would be transferable (which may not be an issue for this proceeding); and, (iii) the effect of a successful challenge of a General Conclusion of Law from the ACFFOD that is incorporated into a Partial Order of Determination, when that Partial Order of Determination is not itself the subject of any exceptions. The latter of these issues (i.e., issue (iii)) is presumably a major motivator for the Agency Seven Recommendations. Under the Committee recommendations, this issue would most likely be joined in Phase 3, as item (C). Committee Letter at 6. In our understanding, the Committee Letter leaves open the possibility that the resolution of a general legal issue could have consequences for Partial Orders that are not themselves the subject of exceptions, or at minimum that there may be parties who would take that position. KPWU take no position on that issue here, either generally or for any specific context or Partial Order. Nor are we opposed to consideration of alternative means or timing to resolve that question.<sup>4</sup>

#### **E. Other Issues**

Although the form of the ultimate decree is not specifically within the scope of the issues for the upcoming Case Management Conference, KPWU believe the Court and parties would benefit by early consideration of that question. As the Court is aware, the Partial Orders of Determination typically incorporate by reference the Proposed Orders of the

KPWU confirm that it has not sought to have the Court modify any water right recognized in a Partial Order of Determination unless KPWU excepted to that specific Partial Order of Determination. At the same time, however, it is uncertain what, if any, the necessary effect of any successful challenge to a General Conclusion of Law may be and it is at least possible there could be claim-specific circumstances that would be relevant to that issue. KPWU believe that it should be possible to resolve the concerns motivating the Agency Seven Recommendations, but that such resolution requires substantive attention that goes beyond current objectives related to the structure of the proceedings.

Administrative Law Judges. More specifically, the Partial Orders of Determination incorporate some portions of Proposed Orders but not others, and Partial Orders of Determination also modify Proposed Orders in whole or in part. Considering that the Court's role is to affirm or modify the ACFFOD including its Partial Orders, this means that the decree, to the extent it modifies a Partial Order, may in some cases do so by modifying the Partial Order, or by modifying text of a Proposed Order, or both. The result could be that the decree proves less efficient or manageable than parties or OWRD or the Court or a reviewing Court would prefer, particularly as one considers that the decree will be in effect for a very long time.

With these considerations in mind, KPWU believe that the Court, OWRD, and the parties should discuss and consider whether the decree that the Court will enter should or can be "self-contained"; that is, whether a single document could include all findings, conclusions, and ordering language, without partial reliance on and reference to other documents for the content of the decree.
