



)	ORDER RE SED PROCEEDINGS
)	UNDER LEVEL 2 RESTRICTIONS

The court previously issued Presiding Judge Orders (PJOs) describing court operations in civil, criminal, family, juvenile and probate cases under Level 2 restrictions in light of the COVID-19 pandemic and the move into the new courthouse. The court continues to look for opportunities to serve the public by expanding services that it can safely provide during the COVID-19 pandemic consistent with the Level 2 restrictions imposed by Chief Justice Order (CJO) 20-016, and will conduct proceedings using remote means where possible and authorized to limit the potential for exposure. The court has concluded that it can resume its Support Enforcement Docket (SED) immediately.

Accordingly, in addition to the proceedings expressly allowed under previously-issued CJOs and PJOs, the court may conduct under Level 2 restrictions the following proceedings: SED contempt proceedings and dockets, including without limitation contempt arraignments, pleas and trials, entry into the PACT program and PACT reviews, probation violation hearings and orders to show cause for judgment debtor exams. All proceedings to be conducted remotely unless the court orders otherwise.
