Parent mentors seek to increase opportunities for parents/caregivers to work within systems to enhance and empower families and continue to raise awareness of early risk factors to justice involvement and increase parent partnership.

Parent Partnership Prelim Project

- A. The law requires a preliminary hearing the day after a youth is arrested and kept in detention. At this hearing, the judge will decide if a youth stays in detention or is released.
- B. For parents to feel empowered, a handbook was created, not intended to provide legal advice, but to help guide you through the system.
- C. Parents, know that you are not alone and this is a stressful time for you, your youth and your family. Take care of yourself and find someone to help guide you.
- D. Community providers have worked to engage and build authentic partnerships with juvenile justice system stakeholders to empower youth and families in the juvenile justice system.
