Case Status	Your Options
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open • Notice Sent • Order to Tow(Active) • Order to Tow/Notice Sent 	These cases are eligible for contesting by submitting a written plea and/or a hearing request, until the case closes.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closed • Order to Tow Inactive 	These cases are <i>not</i> eligible to have a plea submitted but may be eligible to file a 'Motion for Relief of Default Judgment'.
Any case status with an ' Order to Tow ' prefix*	The vehicle is eligible to be towed*(see note) or may already be towed, please contact the Parking Department at 971-274-0590.

**Note: An Order to Tow a Vehicle can be signed at any time, and it could take up to a week or longer for the case to be updated with an Order to Tow case status; meaning although you may not currently see an Order to Tow status, that is not a guarantee that your vehicle will not be towed on an order issued by a judge for outstanding Parking Citations.*
