LOW INCOME TAXPAYER CLINICS

Taxpayers who have appealed to the Magistrate Division because the Oregon Department of Revenue disallowed dependents may be able to get free legal help. There are two clinics in Oregon that may be able to represent low income taxpayers facing this issue. These clinics are not part of either the Oregon Tax Court or the Oregon Department of Revenue. The Court does not endorse or recommend any particular tax clinic or organization.
