Parking Trial by Declaration Instructions

All Parking citations are eligible to proceed with a Trial by Declaration.

A signed request for trial or a plea of Not Guilty is required before you may proceed with a Trial by Declaration. Use the declaration to explain the incident to the judge, the same way you would if you were to appear in court.

The officer, who issued the citation, also has the option to file a sworn statement in support of the citation.

Declarations must be received by the court no later than 5:00 PM of the day before the scheduled trial date.

If you already have a scheduled trial date you only need to complete, and then submit the attached declaration.
