

Yamhill County Circuit Court INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A PRO SE MOTION IN A CRIMINAL CASE

If you choose to file a motion with the court, without an attorney, you may use these instructions and the attached forms as long as what you are requesting is not complex. You must provide the court proof that you served a copy of your motion <u>and</u> the *State's Response* (Form 2 of this packet) to the District Attorney. After you have served both documents to the District Attorney's Office you must indicate on the bottom of your original motion (Form 1) in the *Certificate of Service* section that you did serve them to the District Attorney.

Steps:

- 1. Complete the *Pro Se Motion* Form 1 and sign it. This is now the original that must be filed with the court. (Do not complete the Certificate of Service portion, see step 4).
- 2. Make two copies, 1 for your records and 1 to serve on the District Attorney's office.
- 3. Serve a copy on the District Attorney's office, along with the State's *Response* Form 2.
- 4. On the original *Pro Se Motion* Form 1, complete the *Certificate of Service* portion and sign attesting to your having served the copy of the *Pro Se Motion* and *State's Response* Form 2 on the District Attorney.
- 5. File the completed original *Pro Se Motion* Form 1 with the court.
- 6. Appear at a hearing, if one is scheduled.

The District Attorney's office will have 14 days to indicate whether that office objects to the motion. If they do object, a hearing will be scheduled. If they do not object, the court will review the motion and grant or deny it based on the written motion and any response from the District Attorney's office. A copy of the final order will be sent to you at the address provided.

If you are on formal/supervised probation, you should also obtain a written report from your probation officer stating their position regarding your motion. If there is a victim, the victim may be entitled to notice and an opportunity to object.

The court cannot give legal advice. This is only minimal assistance for persons not represented by an attorney.

DO I NEED A LAWYER?

If you have questions about how the law works or what other issues may arise, you may want to talk to a lawyer. Court staff cannot give you legal advice.
