The table shows the number of petitions that held their first permanency hearing within 425 days, the number that held their first permanency hearing after more than 425 days, and the percentage of first permanency hearings held within 425 days. Cases that have not held a permanency hearing are not included.

Because the report looks at cases that were filed fourteen months prior to the most recent quarter, courts will not appear on this report until at least fourteen months after their Odyssey implementation date.
