

DEPENDENCY PETITIONS FILED, 2003-2020




Dependency Petitions Filed, Statewide

The Time to First Jurisdiction Finding report measures the percentage of dependency cases with a jurisdiction finding within 60 days and 90 days of filing.





*Statistics for 2012-2016 do not include cases filed from October 1 of the year before the court implemented Odyssey through 60 days after the court's Odyssey implementation.

TIME TO JURISDICTION ON BOTH PARENTS, 2015-2020



TIME TO FIRST PERMANENCY HEARING, LOOKING BACK, 2013-2020




Median Days to First Permanency Hearing

- 2) first permanency hearings that were entered after the court's Odyssey implementation on petitions filed prior to Odyssey implementation.


Termination of Parental Rights (TPR) Statistics



Time to TPR Filing


In the chart and table above, a case refers to a child's underlying dependency case. If TPR petitions on the child's parents were filed on separate dates, the latest TPR filing date is used.

*While the statistics in the table and chart above include data from both OJIN and Odyssey, they do not include the following TPR cases:

1. TPR cases entered in OJIN after January 1 of the year the court implemented Odyssey

2. TPR case that were filed in OJIN but not entered as part of the child's existing juvenile case

3. TPR cases entered in Odyssey that do not have party records that match those on an existing dependency case.



TIME FROM DEPENDENCY PETITION TO TPR RESOLUTION, 2013-2020

*The chart and table above contain data from OJIN and Odyssey, and the two datasets define 'resolution' differently. Data from OJIN include all resolutions of TPR cases (regardless of the whether the case resulted on the termination of the parent's rights), whereas data from Odyssey include only cases where the parent's rights were terminated or relinquished. In both the OJIN and Odyssey data, a case refers to a child's underlying dependency case, and the resolution date is the date that the last TPR petition was resolved (in the case of the OJIN data) or that the last parent's rights were terminated or relinquished (in the case of the Odyssey data).

**While the statistics in the table and chart above include data from both OJIN and Odyssey, they do not include the following TPR cases:

- 1. TPR cases entered in OJIN after January 1 of the year the court implemented Odyssey
- 2. TPR cases entered in OJIN but not entered as part of the child's existing juvenile case
- 3. TPR cases filed prior to the court's Odyssey implementation but not resolved until after the court implemented Odyssey
- 4. TPR cases entered in Odyssey that do not have party records that match those on an existing dependency case.
