Pursuant to ORS 135.233 and consistent with CJO No. 22-010, the presiding judge issues the following pretrial release order that specifies which persons or offenses lodged under probable cause arrest are subject to recognizance release, are subject to conditional release and those who should be held until arraignment. This order does not direct release on recognizance, release on conditions, or hold for arraignment persons arrested on contempt charges, probation violations, and post-prison supervision violations.

This order directs the Sheriff or entity supervising the local correctional facility to follow the release determinations for those individuals that are:

- A. Subject to release on recognizance on a release agreement with general conditions pursuant to ORS 135.230;
- B. Subject to release with special conditions as specified in the order; and
- C. Not eligible for release until arraignment.

The Sheriff or entity supervising the local correctional facility will follow the order of release for every person charged with a specific offense for a probable cause arrest or to individual defendants based on criteria provided in this order based on available information through any currently held jail records or known records and other databases to which the jail has direct access.

If a defendant has been held due to overriding circumstances, a representative of the entity determining the hold shall either be at arraignment to report to the judge the overriding circumstances for the hold or provide the information in writing to the judge at or before the arraignment hearing.

This presiding judge order supersedes General Order 2016-04 establishing security schedule for release and release guidelines for the Sheriff or entity supervising correctional facility.

This order establishes a three-step process. Step 1 is to identify the charge and release category. Step 2 is to determine if defendant meets the criteria to consider any overriding circumstances. Step 3 is to determine the conditions of release if appropriate.

Attached to this Order is Exhibit 2 which includes a chart of the release categories, overriding circumstances, and any relevant definitions or crime lists/information (Release Guideline Categorization List). Exhibit 2 is hereby incorporated into this Order. The Release Guideline Categorization List is available at https://www.courts.oregon.gov/programs/pretrial/Documents/ReleaseGuidelinesCategorizationList_FeloniesMisdemeanors.pdf. Any changes to that list are incorporated into this order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Identify Charge and Release Category

Release Category 1: The Clackamas County Sheriff's office or an entity supervising the local correctional facility shall release on personal recognizance on a release agreement with general conditions in ORS 135.250, all defendants charged with the following offenses:

- A. Any non-person misdemeanors, except those offenses listed in Release Category 2 or 3 below;
- B. Any non-person Class C felonies, except those offenses listed in Release Category 2 or 3 below;
- C. Any driving while suspended offense defined in ORS 811.182, except for aggravated driving while suspended as defined in ORS 163.196.
- D. Any other offenses that are not included in Release Category 2 or 3.

Release Category 2: The Clackamas County Sheriff's office or an entity supervising the local correctional facility shall release on conditions imposed by the court, all defendants charged with the following offenses:

- A. Any non-domestic violence person misdemeanor, as defined in OAR 213-003-0001(15);
- B. Any driving under the influence of intoxicants (DUII) offense; and
- C. Any non-domestic violence Class B felony and any non-domestic violence person Class C felony as defined in OAR 213-003-001(14), except for those offenses included in Release Category 3 to be held for arraignment.

Release Category 3: An entity supervising the local correctional facility shall hold for arraignment, first appearance, or other judicial department release decision all defendants charged with the following offenses:

- A. Any violent felony, as defined in ORS 135.240.
- B. Any offense in ORS 137.700 (Ballot Measure 11 Offenses).
- C. Any Class A felony.
- D. Any sex crime (whether designated or not), as defined in ORS 163A.005, including any luring a minor, purchasing sex with a minor, and first-degree invasion of personal

privacy, and any attempt to commit luring a minor, purchasing sex with a minor, and first-degree invasion of personal privacy.

- E. Any domestic violence felony or misdemeanor, as defined in ORS 135.230.
- F. Any felony stalking as described in ORS 163.732, any violation of a stalking protective order as described in ORS 163.750, and felony strangulation as described in ORS 163.187.
- G. Any of the following offenses:
 - 1. Possession of a firearm or dangerous weapon in a public building or court facility, as defined in ORS 166.370; and unlawful possession of machine guns, certain short-barreled firearms, and firearm silencers, as defined in ORS 166.272;
 - 2. Failure to appear, as defined in ORS 162.195 and ORS 162.205;
 - 3. Felon in possession of a firearm, as defined in ORS 166.270;
 - 4. Fleeing or Attempting to Elude, as defined in ORS 811.540;
 - 5. Resisting Arrest, as defined in ORS 162.315;
 - 6. Giving false information to a peace officer, as defined in ORS 807.620 and ORS 162.385;
 - 7. Escape in any degree, as defined in ORS 162.145, ORS 162.155, and ORS 162.165, and Unauthorized Departure, as defined in ORS 162.175;
 - 8. Fugitive from justice, as defined in ORS 133.747; and
 - 9. Tampering with a witness, as defined in ORS 162.285.

SECTION 2: Overriding Circumstances Release Criteria

A: An entity supervising the local correctional facility shall hold for arraignment, first appearance, or other judicial department release decision all defendants who are in Release Category 1 and 2 when one or more of the following overriding circumstances exist:

- 1. A judge specifically orders the Sheriff or entity supervising the local correction facility not to release a defendant meaning the defendant will be held without bail until arraignment.
- 2. A defendant is arrested for a person misdemeanor or person felony and has two or more violent convictions in Oregon within the last five years based on a LEDS review.
- 3. A defendant's Public Safety Checklist (PSC) assessment score falls within one of the following: (1) A felony category score of 80% or above, (2) A person category score of 50% or above, and/or (3) A Property category a score of 80% or above.
- 4. A defendant is on formal probation in Clackamas County.
- 5. A defendant is currently on Clackamas County pre-trial release as determined through a search in the Clackamas County Pretrial Services Database.
- 6. A defendant has additional outstanding warrant(s) and/or holds in other matters.
- 7. A defendant has a case "unsuccessfully closed" with Clackamas County pre-trial services within the last five years as determined through a search in the Clackamas County Pretrial Services database.

8. A defendant has a history of adjudications for contempt of court in Oregon meaning he/she was found twice adjudicated of violating a restraining order and/or no-contact order within the last five years based on a LEDS review.
9. A defendant has a history of failing to appear convictions in Oregon meaning he/she failed to appear for court at least two or more times and was convicted within the last five years based on a LEDS review.
10. A defendant was arrested for a crime, and based on information supplied by the arresting officer in a probable cause statement, involved the possession, use or reference to one of the following weapons: a firearm or knife.
11. A defendant was arrested for one of the following crime(s) that involved a child or a child was present: Criminal Mistreatment I (ORS 163.205), II (ORS 163.200), and/or Child Neglect I (ORS 163.547), II (ORS 163.545).
12. A defendant was arrested for driving under the influence of intoxicants and has two or more convictions for driving under the influence of intoxicants in Oregon within the last ten years based on information in a LEDS review
13. A defendant has an out of state address.
14. A defendant has a pending extradition in another jurisdiction.
15. A defendant has a pending transport order.
16. A defendant was charged with a Bias Crime in any degree, as defined in ORS 166.155 and ORS 166.165, if the probable cause statement indicates the presence of a minor or the threat or use of physical violence.

B: Notwithstanding section 1, release category 3, a defendant charged with giving false information to a peace officer will be subject to release category 2, unless the defendant refuses to provide their true name or an overriding circumstance in section 2(A) applies.

SECTION 3: Conditions of Release

Attached to this order is Exhibit 1 which includes special conditions of release. These conditions shall be used either for the specific offense listed or if defendant meets the criteria for overriding circumstances (if applicable). Attached as Exhibit 2 is the current Release Guideline List. Exhibit 1 and 2 is hereby incorporated into this Order.

SECTION 4: Other Provisions


This Presiding Judge Order is effective July 1, 2022, and continues until modified or rescinded. The Clackamas County Sheriff's Office or entity supervising the local correctional facility shall release, subject to posting security, the following:

- A. A defendant subject to a warrant with stated security issued prior to July 1, 2022; and
- B. A defendant subject to a warrant with stated security issued by another Oregon judicial district.

Notwithstanding any language to the contrary in a warrant issued by another Oregon Judicial District, the CCSO or entity supervising the local correction facility shall apply the

release criteria from this order rather than the release criteria of the other district for defendants subject to warrant from another district.

Category 1 Conditions of Release

Release on personal recognizance on a release agreement with the general conditions in ORS 135.250 and other conditions that include the following:

- Appear to answer the charge in the court having jurisdiction on a day certain and thereafter as ordered by the court until the defendant is discharged or the judgment is entered.
- Submit to the orders and process of the court.
- Not depart this state without leave of the court.
- If charged with any crime against a person, or with contempt of court for violating a court order protecting or prohibiting contact with another person:
 - No contact with victim or protected party, directly or indirectly; and
 - No possession of firearms.
- If alcohol or drugs are implicated in the crime alleged or based on information supplied by the arresting officer in a probable cause statement, then:
 - No consumption or possession of any alcohol or drugs unless prescribed; and
 - No taverns, bars or liquor stores.
- If charged with the crime of Driving While Suspended, no driving or operation of a motor vehicle.
- If represented by an attorney, will maintain weekly contact with said attorney. If not represented and have not already applied for a court appointed attorney, to report to the Clackamas County Courthouse within one (1) day of release to apply for a court appointed attorney.

Category 2 Conditions of Release

Release on personal recognizance on a release agreement with the general conditions in ORS 135.250 and other conditions that include the following:

- Appear to answer the charge in the court having jurisdiction on a day certain and thereafter as ordered by the court until the defendant is discharged or the judgment is entered;
- Submit to the orders and process of the court;
- Not depart this state without leave of the court;
- If charged with any crime against a person, or with contempt of court for violating a court order protecting or prohibiting contact with another person:

- No contact with victim or protected party, directly or indirectly; and
- No possession of firearms.
- If alcohol or drugs are implicated in the crime alleged or based on information supplied by the arresting officer in a probable cause statement, then:
 - No consumption or possession of any alcohol or drugs unless prescribed; and
 - No taverns, bars or liquor stores.
- If charged with the crime of Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants:
 - No consumption of alcohol;
 - No entry into taverns, bars or liquor stores;
 - No driving without a license and if Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV) requires, ignition interlock device (IID);
 - Placed on pre-trial supervision with an enhanced level of supervision unless otherwise authorized by the court. The enhanced level of supervision requires a check in by phone or in person with the Pretrial Services Office (PSO) once monthly or at intervals to be determined by the PSO.
- If represented by an attorney, will maintain weekly contact with said attorney. If not represented and have not already applied for a court appointed attorney, to report to the Clackamas County Courthouse within one (1) day of release to apply for a court appointed attorney.

Category 3 Conditions of Release:

Pursuant to ORS 169.042 – 169.046, and Clackamas County Board Order No. 2018 – 118, which by this reference is incorporated herein, should the jail release a person in Category 3 because of overpopulation at the Clackamas County Jail, release on personal recognizance on a release agreement shall include the general conditions in ORS 135.250 and other conditions that include the following:

- Appear to answer the charge in the court having jurisdiction on a day certain and thereafter as ordered by the court until the defendant is discharged or the judgment is entered;
- Submit to the orders and process of the court;
- Not depart this state without leave of the court;
- If charged with any crime against a person, or with contempt of court for violating a court order protecting or prohibiting contact with another person:
 - No contact with victim or protected party, directly or indirectly; and
 - No possession of firearms.
- If alcohol or drugs are implicated in the crime alleged or based on information supplied by the arresting officer in a probable cause statement, then:
 - No consumption or possession of any alcohol or drugs unless prescribed; and
 - No taverns, bars or liquor stores.

- If charged with any offense in Category 3, the court shall include as a condition of the release agreement that the defendant not contact the victim of the violence to include the following:
 - No contact with victim, directly or indirectly;
 - No entry into premises, business or other location occupied by the victim;
- Not possess or have access to firearms or other deadly weapons.
- If charged with a Sex Crime:
 - No unsupervised contact with minors; and
 - No entering into areas where minors commonly are present – schools, parks, churches, playgrounds, fast-food restaurants, or similar places.
- If charged with any offense in Category 3, placed on pre-trial supervision with an intensive level of supervision unless otherwise authorized by the court. The intensive level of supervision requires a check a check in by phone or in person with the Pretrial Services Office (PSO) twice monthly or at intervals to be determined by the PSO. Other conditions imposed could include reporting for random urinalysis or other testing, curfew, wearing SCRAM, GPS or other monitoring device.
- If represented by an attorney, will maintain weekly contact with said attorney. If not represented and have not already applied for a court appointed attorney, to report to the Clackamas County Courthouse within one (1) day of release to apply for a court appointed attorney.

Overriding Circumstances Release Criteria

An entity supervising the local correctional facility shall hold for arraignment, first appearance, or other judicial department release decision all defendants who are in Release Category 1 and 2 when one or more of the following overriding circumstances exist.

Overriding Criteria A.1.: A judge specifically orders the Sheriff or entity supervising the local correction facility not to release a defendant meaning the defendant will be held without bail until arraignment.

Overriding Criteria A.2: A defendant is arrested for a person misdemeanor or person felony and has two or more violent convictions in Oregon within the last five years based on a LEDS review.

Person Misdemeanor or Person Felony: The list of person misdemeanors and person felonies are in the Overriding Criteria #3, which by this reference is incorporated herein.

Violent Conviction: A “violent conviction” means a conviction for a crime that caused physical injury, serious physical injury or sexual victimization. . . See ORS 135.240(6). These crimes include the following: An Ballot Measure Eleven Offense (See Endnote VI) and any Sex Crime (See Endnote VII) or an attempt to commit one of these crimes. A violent conviction also includes Assault III and IV, Menacing; Strangulation; Criminal Mistreatment I; Assaulting a Public Safety Officer.

Overriding Criteria A.3: A defendant’s Public Safety Checklist (PSC) assessment score falls within one of the following: (1) A felony category score of 80% or above, (2) A person category score of 50% or above, and/or (3) A Property category a score of 80% or above.

Overriding Criteria A.4: A defendant is on formal probation in Clackamas County.

Overriding Criteria A.5: A defendant is currently on Clackamas County pre-trial release as determined through a search in the Clackamas County Pretrial Services Database.

Overriding Criteria A.6: A defendant has additional outstanding warrant(s) and/or holds in other matters.

Overriding Criteria A.7: A defendant has a case “unsuccessfully closed” with Clackamas County pre-trial services within the last five years as determined through a search in the Clackamas County Pretrial Services database.

Overriding Criteria A.8: A defendant has a history of adjudications for contempt of court in Oregon meaning he/she was found twice adjudicated of violating a restraining order and/or no-contact order within the last five years based on a LEDS review.

Overriding Criteria A.9: A defendant has a history of failing to appear convictions in Oregon meaning he/she failed to appear for court at least two or more times and was convicted within the last five years based on a LEDS review.

Overriding Criteria A.10: A defendant was arrested for a crime, and based on information supplied by the arresting officer in a probable cause statement, involved the possession, use or reference to one of the following weapons: a firearm or knife.

Overriding Criteria A.11: A defendant was arrested for one of the following crime(s) that involved a child or a child was present: Criminal Mistreatment I (ORS 163.205), II (ORS 163.200), and/or Child Neglect I (ORS 163.547), II (ORS 163.545).

Overriding Criteria A.12: A defendant was arrested for driving under the influence of intoxicants and has two or more convictions for driving under the influence of intoxicants in Oregon within the last ten years based on information in a LEDS review.

Overriding Criteria A.13: A defendant has an out of state address.

Overriding Criteria A.14: A defendant has a pending extradition in another jurisdiction.

Overriding Criteria A.15: A defendant has a pending transport order.

Overriding Criteria A.16: Bias Crime in any degree, as defined in ORS 166.155 and ORS 166.165.

Overriding Criteria A.17: Failure to Register as a Sex Offender, as defined in ORS 163A.040.

Overriding Circumstances Release Criteria - Conditions of Release

Pursuant to ORS 169.042 – 169.046, and Clackamas County Board Order No. 2018 – 118, which by this reference is incorporated herein, should the jail release a person in Category 3 because of overpopulation at the Clackamas County Jail, release on personal recognizance on a release agreement shall include the general conditions in ORS 135.250 and other conditions that include the following:

- Appear to answer the charge in the court having jurisdiction on a day certain and thereafter as ordered by the court until the defendant is discharged or the judgment is entered;
- Submit to the orders and process of the court;
- Not depart this state without leave of the court;

- If charged with any offense in Category 3, the court shall include as a condition of the release agreement that the defendant not contact the victim of the violence to include the following:
 - No contact with victim, directly or indirectly;
 - No entry into premises, business or other location occupied by the victim;
- Not possess or have access to firearms or other deadly weapons.
- If charged with a Sex Crime:
 - No unsupervised contact with minors; and
 - No entering into areas where minors commonly are present – schools, parks, churches, playgrounds, fast-food restaurants, or similar places.

About the Release Guidelines Categorization List

Purpose

The Office of the State Court Administrator (OSCA) is publishing this Release Guidelines Categorization List as required by [Chief Justice Order \(CJO\) No. 22-010](#). Section 2 of Oregon Laws 2021, chapter 643, now codified as ORS 135.223, requires the Chief Justice to establish release guidelines for Presiding Judge standing pretrial release orders. CJO 22-010 established those release guidelines and directed the State Court Administrator to determine the release guideline category into which each Oregon felony and misdemeanor falls and create a list setting out that determination.

The Release Guidelines Categorization List is intended to be available as a tool to assist the sheriff of the county, or the entity supervising the local correctional facility, with the application of the release guidelines established by CJO No. 22-010.

OSCA has also made available an Excel spreadsheet that lists each offense by statute number and allows for searching by statute number and sorting by specified categories (e.g., guideline category, penalty level, type of offense). The spreadsheet is available on the [OJD Pretrial Program website](#).

Changes to Previous Release Guidelines Categorization List (Published July 1, 2022)

This is the second Release Guidelines Categorization List issued by the State Court Administrator, and it is effective on July 21, 2022. This list supersedes the Release Guidelines Categorization List published on July 1, 2022, and reflects the following substantive changes:

- Corrected the categorization of Harassment (non-domestic violence), a Class A misdemeanor under ORS 166.065(4), from Guideline 1 (Release on Recognizance) to Guideline 2 (Release with Court-Imposed Conditions); and
- Clarified the statutory citation for Harassment under the list of potential misdemeanor crimes of domestic violence in Guideline 3 (Hold for Arraignment).

The list otherwise remains the same as published on July 1, 2022.

This list will be reviewed and updated on a quarterly basis to reflect changes to statutes or orders. A version history is captured in page iii with publishing dates and a brief description of changes.

Release Guidelines Categories

CJO No. 22-010 established the following release guideline categories:

- Guideline 1: Release on recognizance, which includes
 - Any non-person misdemeanor, except those offenses listed in Guideline 2 or 3;
 - Any non-person Class C felony, except those listed in Guideline 2 or 3;
 - Any driving while suspended offense, except for aggravated driving while suspended; and
 - Any other offense that is not included in Guideline 2 or 3.
- Guideline 2: Release with court-imposed conditions, which includes:

- Any non-domestic violence person misdemeanor;
 - Any driving while under the influence of intoxicants (DUII) offense;
 - Any non-domestic violence Class B felony and any non-domestic violence person Class C felony, except for those offenses included in Guideline 3.
- Guideline 3: Hold for arraignment, first appearance, or release decision under ORS 135.253(3)(b), which includes:
 - Any violent felony or any offense in ORS 137.700;
 - Any Class A felony;
 - Any sex crime (whether designated or not) and certain specified offenses;
 - Any domestic violence felony or misdemeanor;
 - Any felony stalking, any violation of a stalking protective order, and felony strangulation; and
 - Specified offenses.

Hold for arraignment, first appearance, or a release decision under ORS 135.235(3)(b)

- ORS 163.385, 163.395, 163.405: Sodomy in any degree
- ORS 163.408, 163.411: Unlawful sexual penetration in any degree
- ORS 163.413: Purchasing sex with a minor
- ORS 163.415, 163.425, 163.427: Sexual abuse in any degree
- ORS 163.432, 163.433: Online sexual corruption of a child in any degree with reasonable knowledge of a five-year (or more) age difference
- ORS 163.435: Contributing to the sexual delinquency of a minor
- ORS 163.445, 163.452, 163.454: Sexual misconduct if the offender is over 18 years of age
- ORS 163.465(2)(b), 163.467: Public or private indecency with a prior sex crime conviction
- ORS 163.525: Incest with a child victim
- ORS 163.670: Using a child in a display of sexually explicit conduct
- ORS 163.684, 163.686, 163.687: Encouraging child sexual abuse in any degree
- ORS 163.688: Possession of materials depicting sexually explicit conduct of a child in the first degree
- ORS 163.701: Invasion of personal privacy in the first degree
- ORS 164.215, 164.225: Burglary in any degree, when the intended crime is a sex crime
- ORS 167.012: Promoting prostitution
- ORS 167.017: Compelling prostitution
- ORS 167.057: Luring a minor
- ORS 167.333: Sexual assault of an animal, where the offense is designated as a sex crime

- **Any domestic violence felony or misdemeanor (ORS 135.230).**

- Includes any attempt of a domestic violence felony or misdemeanor

ORS 135.230 defines "domestic violence" as abuse between family or household members.

"Abuse" means:

- *Attempting to cause or intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly causing physical injury;*
- *Intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly placing another in fear of imminent serious physical injury; or*
- *Committing sexual abuse in any degree as defined in ORS 163.415, 163.425, and 163.427.*

"Family or household members" means any of the following:

- *Spouses or former spouses.*

- *Adult persons related by blood or marriage.*
- *Persons cohabitating with each other.*
- *Persons who have cohabitated with each other or been involved in a sexually intimate relationship.*
- *Unmarried parents of a minor child.*

Misdemeanor DV offenses include, but are not limited to:

- ORS 163.160: Assault in the fourth degree
- ORS 163.187: Strangulation
- ORS 163.212: Use of ESG/tear gas/mace in the second degree
- ORS 163.415: Sexual abuse in the third degree
- ORS 166.025: Disorderly conduct in the second degree
- ORS 166.065(3), (4): Harassment
- ORS 166.155(1)(b), 166.155(1)(c): Bias crime in the second degree
- ORS 166.190: Pointing a firearm at another
- ORS 811.060: Vehicular assault

- **Any felony stalking, as described in ORS 163.732, any violation of a stalking protective order as described in ORS 163.750, and felony strangulation as described in ORS 163.187;**
- **Any of the following offenses²:**
 - ORS 133.747: Fugitive from justice
 - ORS 162.145, 162.155, 162.165: Escape in any degree
 - ORS 162.175: Unauthorized departure
 - ORS 162.195, 162.205: Failure to appear in any degree
 - ORS 162.285: Tampering with a witness
 - ORS 162.315: Resisting arrest
 - ORS 162.385: Giving false information to a peace officer
 - ORS 166.270: Felon in possession of a firearm
 - ORS 166.272: Unlawful possession of machine guns, certain short-barreled firearms, and firearm silencers
 - ORS 166.370: Possession of a firearm or dangerous weapon in a public building or court facility
 - ORS 807.620: Giving false information to a peace officer
 - ORS 811.540: Fleeing or attempting to elude
