I HEREBY FIND:

- 1. State and Federal COVID states of emergency have been lifted.
- 2. Remote civil commitment proceedings for allegedly mentally ill person (AMIPs) create a concern of procedural fairness that outweighs any inconvenience to the court in having commitment hearings held at the AMIP's hospital or facility.

The court will take steps to ensure that off site civil commitment hearings comply with state constitutional open court requirements, including broadcasting the proceeding by Webex at the courthouse, if necessary, or by providing information about the date, time and location of hearings to the public.
