What is DISP?

DISP is an Intensive Supervision Program that provides supervision, treatment, accountability, and a variety of support services to individuals dealing with addiction who have a history of DUII convictions. DISP is designed to help participants establish and maintain a life free of alcohol and drug abuse for the duration of probation and beyond. We believe that taking these steps will greatly improve their life, as well as the safety and security of our community

WHO

DISP consists of partners from Multnomah County Circuit Court, Multnomah County Department of Community Justice, Multnomah Defenders Office, Multnomah County District Attorney's Office, Treatment Services Northwest, and Volunteers of America Oregon. To be eligible, participants must obtain a current substance use disorder (SUD) assessment indicating a need for intensive SUD treatment, screen high risk for repeat DUII, and meet other program eligibility.

WHAT

DISP participants can expect to appear in court regularly, receive intensive supervision of their probation, substance use treatment, and random and frequent drug testing. There are Five Phases in DISP, each Phase consists of various objectives. The program uses incentives and sanctions to promote behavior change.
