
Jury Orientation







- Jurors generally serve no more than 10 days
- Juror Pay
 - \$10/day for first two days
 - \$25/day for each day thereafter
 - \$.20/mi for travel from your home
- Unavailability Dates
 - Any date you are unable to serve (out of town, medical appt, childcare...etc)



Jury Service Cont.

- Required to call or check website each week
 - 541.426.1041
 - courts.oregon.gov/courts/wallowa/jury
- Call in date may change (check each week)
- If your Juror # is called, press 9 and speak your Juror #

Jury Service Cont.

- Contact information
 - Please provide the Court with a phone number/email address
 - Only used for Jury-related purposes
- Pre-excused absence
 - You will not be called to serve on jury if you have informed the Court
 - We must have between 35-70 jurors for each trial
- Accessibility
 - Please inform Court staff of any accommodations you require



How to respond to your summons:

- . Login using your 10-digit Juror ID found on your summons.
- The court asks for your phone number and email to provide instant and important updates related to your service.
- · You MUST complete and submit the questionnaire to request an excusal or deferral from service.
- · When finished with the form, please submit only one time.
- . In the profile screen, verify your Personal Information is correct.






*Your mobile device or browser should be in landscape/full screen mode to properly complete the online jury response form.

If you need to get in contact with the court regarding your service, email or call your local jury office directly.

Reschedule Your Jury Service

If you are looking to reschedule your jury service, please select the "Defer Service" tab and select the new date on the calendar. Once you have chosen your new date, you will receive a new summons in the mail one month prior to your reporting date.

· Request an Excusal

If you believe you should be excused by law, select the "Excuse Service" tab. Once you have submitted your request, select the "Profile/Status" tab to verify the status of your service. It may take up to 48 hours to process your request.

Proof of Service

Proof of jury service is available once you have completed your jury service. Click on "Print Letters" and select "Attendance Letter" after your service.




Jurors 01-100 are required to report to the Wallowa Courthouse on Thursday, July 04, 2024 at 8:15am.



Employer Protections

PAYMENTS

Dress Code (SLR 3.011)

Proper attire and appropriate behavior is required by everyone entering the Wallowa County Circuit Court and will be strictly enforced. This includes defendants, witnesses, jurors, attorneys as well as all court personnel. Anyone arriving in the courtroom dressed improperly may be sent away until properly attired.

Please remember, this is a formal occasion and your choice of clothing reflects an attitude when appearing before the court.

Attorneys, it is your responsibility to see that your clients are aware of the dress code for the courtroom.

The following apparel items are unacceptable for anyone entering the courtroom:

- Tube tops, tank tops, halter tops, bare midriff tops, low cut blouses, see through tops, spaghetti straps, halter tops, or anything that is backless.
- 2. Sheer or lacy tops are allowed as long as appropriate garment or camisole is worn to cover undergarments.
- 3. Dresses or skirts shorter than the fingertips of extended arms. Must be modestly covered while bending, reaching or sitting.
- 4. Shorts (on men or women). No pajama pants.
- 5. Skirts or pants with waists that allow undergarments to be seen. No sagging, bagging or dragging pants.
- 6. Clothing that is dirty or that has large holes; cut-off sleeves or pants.
- Hats or bandanas/do-rags.
- Clothing that display controlled substances (tobacco, alcohol, drugs), double meanings, hate motivated behavior, illegal activities, obscene gestures or language, profanity, sexual references, or violence.
- 9. Slippers, bare feet, rubber shoes or flip flops (dress sandals are allowed).
- 10. Chains that could be used as weapons.
- 11. Garments meant to be worn as undergarments, worn as outer garments.
- 12. Leggings when worn alone (allowed if worn as tights).
