## **Rules and Expectations for Criminal Judicial Settlement Conferences**

The court expects the state, defense and the defendant to appear for the settlement conference. The process will involve speaking to the lawyers and then speaking to the defendant. A confidential settlement memorandum not more than <a href="two">two</a> (2) pages should be submitted to assist the judge in understanding the aspects of the case. It must be submitted <a href="MO LATER THAN">NO LATER THAN</a> 12:00 PM THE DAY BEFORE the JSC for the court to review. The memo should address the following things:

- 1. Who is your client and what should I know about them?
- 2. What facts are in dispute?
- 3. What are the defenses that are being asserted?
- 4. Obstacles to settlement to date from your client's perspective.
- 5. Are there any pending legal issues that might impact settlement? (Pending motions?)

As Washington County has a limited number of trial judges, each party will be required to sign a waiver of any conflict of me acting as both settlement judge and later as the trial judge. I would not likely take a jury waiver on a case I had a settlement conference. I look forward to trying to assist in resolving your dispute.
