About the Exam

The Written Examination consists of 135 questions. Questions will cover: English language, court related terms and usage, ethics and professional conduct. The criminal history check will be conducted to assure that there are no barriers to holding the certified credential. Candidates must pass the Written Exam before they are eligible to take the Oral Exam.

Registration Process

Candidates must complete the online registration form, the Law Enforcement Data Systems (LEDS) Record Check, and pay the appropriate fee by 3:00 PM on October 28, 2024. The address for the exam will be provided with the candidate's confirmation.

Language Assessment

As part of the registration process, candidates who have not already done so will be asked to participate in a language assessment for both English and their non-English language. The assessments are not interpreting exams rather they are designed to measure a candidate's level of bilingualism in both languages. The results have no effect on the candidate's ability to participate in the court interpreter certification process.

The assessments will be provided at no cost to the candidate. The assessments are taken over the phone, take 20-30 minutes, each and are scheduled on a date and time of the candidate's choosing. Candidates will be responsible for scheduling both the English and non-English assessments through CLAS. More information on scheduling procedures will be provided upon receipt of registration and payment.
