Required partnership between CIP program (JCIP), the state child welfare agency, and at least one tribal government. Identify needs and creative ways to solve them. Will be with JCIP, ODHS, and the Klamath Tribes. North Dakota, Alaska, Minnesota, Nebraska, and Oregon are the five grantees. Meeting in January for the kickoff.

Judge Perez: Group consists of Judge Perez, Referee Underwood, Judge Temple, Judge Collins, Judge Simmons, Judge Benjamin, Judge Hung, Judge Landis, Judge Sternhagen, Judge Kittson-MaQatish, Referee Hughes, Referee Almquist, and Referee Hagedorn.
